**Good afternoon parents and carers,**

**Welcome back to Term 2.**

Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding through this season. Our staff continue in their commitment to provide 'Excellence in Education' and have given much time and energy in recent weeks to planning high quality curriculum delivery through the months ahead. To ensure equity for all involved, students at home and at school will receive the same instruction (live stream lessons), class resources and learning activities. With only the children of essential workers attending school in the coming weeks, classroom and lunchtime supervision through the school day will be managed by a roster of teachers, teacher aides and school leaders. Students involved in our Learning from Home program will work under the supervision of parents at home.

**Arrival Time**

Students should not arrive to school before 8.15am. Student supervision will begin at 8.45am.

**Drop and Go**

Parents are asked to use the Bus Bay to drop students. We ask that parents don't park or come to the classrooms. Staff will be on hand to direct traffic and student arrivals.

**Temperature Checks and Roll Marking**

All students will have their temperature checked on arrival at the Bus Bays, before moving to class areas. They will be marked present on our rolls and will be directed to classrooms. If students present with a temperature, you will be contacted to collect your child immediately.

**Playgrounds and Breaks**

In order to ensure social distancing and hygiene, student numbers in playground areas will be limited. Cleaning of playground equipment will be undertaken each afternoon. Lunch areas will be supervised and also cleaned daily.

**Bus Travel Students**

All students arriving by bus are required to report directly to the Arrival Station at the Bus Bay. Afternoon departures remain as per normal.

**Afternoon Pickup**

All Secondary students are to be picked up from the bottom car park. Primary students are to be picked up from the bus bays. If you have both Secondary and Primary children, start with the Secondary pick up and move to the bus bay collection point. Staff will be on hand to supervise students until 3.15pm.

**Learning Packs**

Student Learning packs (if applicable) will be issued to students on Monday. They will keep these packs in the classroom.

**Homework**

There will be no Homework issued during Term 2.
