Good afternoon Parents

As you would be aware, the Government has approved a return to school for all Queensland students from Monday, May 25. As such, the College will **no longer** be providing 'Learning from Home' lesson arrangements from this date. If you have children that will remain at home for health reasons, please notify the Administration office asap. These students will be provided with some learning materials via their class teacher.

Timetables and Activities

From Monday, May 25, all classes will revert to the normal 2020 timetable commencing with **Week B**. Specialist lessons and Instrumental Music (including bands) will also recommence, as well as lunchtime clubs and activities, and access to our Learning Hub.

Homework Hub

Homework Hub will not operate until Term 3.

Tuckshop

The Tuckshop will be open from 25 May. Orders can be placed online. Cash is still accepted but cashless options are preferred where possible.

School Buses

All school bus services will be operating including the CCC buses.

Uniform

The Uniform Shop will be open by appointment at the usual times - Monday 8am to 10:30am and Wednesday 2:30pm to 4:00pm.

Solid Grounds Coffee

Solid Grounds Coffee will operate for takeaway and onsite service (up to 10 people), Monday to Friday from 8am to 1.30pm. Please park near the ELC and walk down the access road to Solid Grounds to limit access to the school grounds.

Drop off and Pick up

Drop-off and pick-up arrangements are detailed below. Supervision will be provided for younger students to move to and from cars safely. To reduce congestion, please do not arrive at the College before 3pm. Parents will be issued with a dashboard label (includes surname and zone colour) to assist with traffic control. Parents are to remain in or beside their car to minimise adults on the College campus.

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Student and Staff Safety

Temperature stations will continue to be manned by CCC staff as students arrive at the morning drop off zones, to safeguard the health of our staff and students. Regular hand washing and hygiene will be a part of daily routines. Students are not required to maintain a 1.5-metre distance, but where appropriate, they will be asked to find their own space.

Leaving the school grounds

No student is permitted to leave the school grounds during the day except where they are picked up by a parent or carer via the office.

Volunteers and Parent meetings

Thank you to all our wonderful College volunteers. At this stage, we are unable to welcome you back until further notice. All parent meetings will be conducted online using MS Teams. Any visits to the school should be limited, and arrivals must occur through the College office.

Academic Reports and Parent Interviews

Student reports will be issued in Week 3 of Term 3. Parent Teacher interviews will be conducted online and will be booked through Parent Lounge. Details will be published early next term. The last few weeks of Term 2 will be used to consolidate learning and ensure students successfully return to their routine at school.

Camps and Excursions, Chapel and Assembly

Camps and excursions will be arranged in line with government guidelines. Chapel and Assembly will continue to run in class groups using MS Teams. At this stage, larger gatherings are restricted, even in schools.

We know that the 'new normal' will take a little getting used to, but we look forward to having everyone back at school again. Thank you for working with us during the 'Learning from Home' phase. We have seen some amazing learning and creative responses from students and staff (including Teacher Aides, our Enrichment and Pastoral Care teams).
