Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As you may be aware the Queensland Government has declared a three-day lockdown of the Greater Brisbane area; including Ipswich, Logan, Redlands, Moreton Bay and Brisbane council areas.

Any person who has visited or stopped over in this area since Saturday 20th March must self-isolate from Monday 29th March 5pm until Thursday 1st April 5pm. If you have been in contact with someone from the Greater Brisbane area, but have not visited yourself, you do not need to isolate.

Group Gatherings

Private gatherings for the entire state of Queensland are restricted to 30 people for the three day lockdown. Therefore, we believe it is prudent not to hold our weekly Primary and Secondary Assemblies and Chapel Services until the ban is lifted. These are now suspended for the remainder of the term.

Other group gatherings such as Little Arrows Playgroup and Netball and Football Academies will also be suspended for the remainder of the term.

Cross Country and Colour Explosion

The whole school Cross Country and Colour Explosion event on Thursday 1st April will be postponed until the beginning of Term 2. We know many parents, staff and students will be disappointed with the change to these highly anticipated events.

We look forward to holding and running these events as a community so will share details early in Term 2.

Instrumental Lessons

Any instrumental lessons that are missed over coming days due to teachers and students being absent will have them credited in Term 2.

Outback Service Trip

Our Outback Service Team has left on their trip. None of the staff or students have been in the Greater Brisbane area since the 20th March so plans will continue to be reviewed and adjustments made as required.

Important Information for the next 3 days

Classes will go ahead over the next three days, although some classes may be combined depending on supervision needs. If your child cannot attend school, please notify Administration by phone or email. Please be assured that students who miss important exams or assessments will have opportunity to catch-up at an alternative date, these details will be communicated by teachers.
