COVID-19 HEALTH DIRECTIVES

Dear Parent/Carer

As the situation in Victoria continues to decline in relation to COVID-19, it is important that we stay vigilant to ensure the health and wellbeing of our College community.

We continue to source our information from both the Federal and Queensland Governments to inform our decision-making.

I would like to reiterate the following:

If you have a **confirmed case** of COVID-19, then you must immediately self-isolate (stay home, do not have close contact with anyone).

If you have **suspected** case of COVID-19 (symptoms of COVID-19 and have been in close contact with a confirmed case), then you must immediately self-isolate.

If you have been in **close contact** with someone else with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (but have no symptoms), then you must immediately self-quarantine (stay home, do not have close contact with anyone).

If **someone in your household is in self-quarantine**, then other members of the household are not required to go into self-quarantine; however, they must maintain appropriate physical distancing from the person in their household who is in quarantine.

If you have had **casual contact** with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (less than 15 minutes in close contact, less than 2 hours in a shared closed space) , you are not required to go into quarantine unless symptoms of ill health are experienced.

Please note that a health directive from the Government supersedes all of the above. If you are directed to self-isolate or self-quarantine, then you must do so.

As the weather becomes cooler, and we have our annual season of colds, viruses, and bugs, I would ask that parents and carers please keep their child/ren at home if they are unwell. This is to limit the spread amongst the rest of the College community.

If your child is unwell and attends the College, please be aware that the Administration Office may contact you to collect your child and keep them home until they have recovered.
