CONDITIONS & EXPECTATIONS

- Both existing CCC students and new students are able to apply for scholarships to begin in Year 4, Year 7 and Year 10.
- Each scholarship will be offered for a three year period.
- Scholarship intake will occur the year prior (eg. a Year 3 student will apply in Term 3 for a scholarship to commence the following year).

Instrumental Music Scholarship students will be required to:

1. Continue lessons/tuition in their chosen instrument either with our tutors or privately
2. Be a committed member of one or more of the college ensembles, concert band or jazz band, attending rehearsals (one per week) and performances as scheduled
3. Maintain passing academic grades in all other studies
4. Maintain and uphold the behavioural expectations and values of the College, and represent the College well in public performances

The College will provide:

1. Free tuition for one instrument at school (subject to availability of a qualified tutor)
2. Free hire of your selected instrument (if required)
3. Tuition fee relief, to the value of \$1000 per year, for the first three years of enrolment
