The College is committed to not only providing all students with an excellent learning experience, but also recognising the high standard of achievement reached and maintained by students.

POLICY STATEMENT

Cooloola Christian College offers scholarships in order to attract potential students, as well as retain and support its existing students.

Scholarships are offered in 'Leadership', 'Sport', 'Instrumental' and 'Academic' fields, not only to potential students but also existing students in key transition areas.

Each scholarship is for a three-year period.

The College will provide tuition fee relief to the value of \$1,000 per year, as well as other opportunities to further develop skills in the relevant field.

- **Leadership Scholarship**
Open to students in Year 6 (for Years 7, 8 and 9) and Year 9 (for Years 10, 11 and 12)
- **Instrumental Scholarship**
Open to students in Year 3 (for Years 4, 5 and 6) students in Year 6 (for Years 7, 8 and 9) and Year 9 (for Years 10, 11 and 12)
- **Sport Scholarship**

Open to students in Year 3 (for Years 4, 5 and 6) students in Year 6 (for Years 7, 8 and 9) and Year 9 (for Years 10, 11 and 12)

- **Academic (formerly STEM) Scholarship**

Open to students in Year 3 (for Years 4, 5 and 6) students in Year 6 (for Years 7, 8 and 9) and Year 9 (for Years 10, 11 and 12)

Students are only eligible to be awarded a scholarship in one field only.

An intake period for scholarship applications will occur in Term 3, for commencement the following year.

Scholarships will be shortlisted and awarded by a Scholarship Committee, which comprises of:

- CCC Principal
- Business Manager
- Board Vice-Chairperson

Scholarships are awarded primarily based on merit. Additional criteria is specified within the individual application forms.

Scholarships are limited and submission of an application or selection for an interview does not guarantee an offer.

Students who receive a scholarship will be reported to the Senior Leadership Team.

Scholarships are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another student.

Awarded scholarships will be reviewed each year by the Scholarship Committee to ensure that students are continuing to demonstrate attributes that qualified them for the scholarship. If a student does not continue to demonstrate the attributes that qualified them for the scholarship, the offer of this scholarship will be removed.
